Please be considerate and do not dump your household trash in the burn pile. When you do, someone else has to remove it. The only items allowed at the compost site are grass, leaves, tree branches, trees not to exceed 8 feet. No lumber, building materials (of any kind), cardboard, metals, plastics, or other debris are not permitted.
