Special Council Meeting Amended – December 12, 2023

Acting Mayor C. Strom called the meeting to order at 5:30 p.m.

Council members present: T. Carlson, M. Kjelland. P. Shablow was absent.

Public Present: L. Braget, L. Klegstad, M. Hawk, D. Anderson, D. Hartsock, R. Shablow, K. Hanson, P. Klegstad.

The pledge to the American Flag was given.

Strom invited the public to comment on the increase on the budget and the proposed taxes for 2024. Several of the audience attending commented that they thought the tax increase on the proposed taxes was too much for one year.

Members of the council discussed the increases in insurance and other bills for the city. It was said that for the past 7 years the total tax increase was 13% and the public was assured that the taxes would be reduced before the final budget is sent to the county. The school gym was discussed. A council member said the gym is a large expense and if the public wanted to raise money to keep the gym open then they are welcome to do that. Heating the gym currently costs about \$6,000.00 per year. The council said that the bus shed will not be getting a new tin roof as planned for in the 2024 proposed budget.

The council will vote at the next regular meeting to possibly close the gym for the winter months ahead.

The council reviewed the 2024 budget options and directed the clerk to prepare two budget options for the next council meeting. At that time the council will vote on the final budget.

At 8:24 pm Carlson made a motion, Kjelland seconded to adjourn to the next regular scheduled council meeting December 18, 2023 at 5:30 p.m.
