Dates to run water bills: Shablow said that the water bills should be run the last Thursday of the month.

LMC Insurance:

Lawn mower: Schmiedeberg said he had called round looking for a lawn mower to replace the old mower the city had purchased in 2016. Schmiedeberg feels the best deal is from Roseau Co-Op for a 2025 Altos mower at \$11,500.00. Maintenance Report: Schmiedeberg said some signs need to be fixed and he found supplies in storage to fix them. Schmiedeberg said he will mark the curb stops along highway 59 for the MNDOT.

Council Roundtable: Kjelland asked what the plan was for snow removal this coming winter. Schmiedeberg said it will be the same as it was last winter.
